To obtain a Mercer County Senior ID you must be a Mercer County Resident and be 62 years of age or older. Forms to apply are available in the main office, please have your Senior Center Member ID with you.

"Ident-Adult" is an emergency identification card provided by the Sheriff's Office, specifically for senior citizens. The card contains your name, address, telephone number, whom to contact in a medical emergency, doctor's name and phone number, illnesses, and allergies. Should a senior become incapacitated by sudden illness and cannot speak or remember, the Ident-Adult card can speak for the cardholder, providing vital contact and medical information.

Forms must be completed and returned to the Main Office by Monday - April 15th. Once forms are filled out, The Mercer County Sherriff's office will create your ID, take your picture and distribute them on Tuesday - April 23rd between 10am and 12pm.
