



FREE GROCERY DELIVERY FOLLOWING HOSPITALIZATION

We understand that many leave the hospital in a state of food insecurity, unable to immediately return to work, experiencing other mobility or transportation limitations, or ongoing financial limitations.

You may be eligible for **two weekly deliveries** via the JFCS DoorDash program.

The JFCS DoorDash program will deliver directly to your door following your hospital discharge and once more the following week to help you through the recovery time.

How it Works

- Scan the code to access the online enrollment form.
- First deliveries will be made Monday-Thursday.
- Second, final deliveries will be made the following Wednesday.
- Requests sent Thursday afternoon thru Sunday will be delivered the next Monday.
- **Must be a Mercer County resident, some restrictions apply.**

What's in a bag?

Bags include fresh produce, choice of protein, shelf-stable milk, and assorted pantry items: pasta, rice, tortillas, cereal, applesauce, peanut butter, etc.

Bags do NOT include prepared meals, items require preparation & storage.

For those leaving the hospital after giving birth, a post-partum supplemental bag can be requested with food specific to your post-partum health needs.
